



Devil's Dyke Regional Event

Sunday October 15th

Final Details

Southdowns Orienteers welcome you to Devil's Dyke and hope that you enjoy your run. We are grateful to the National Trust for allowing us the use of the area.

Location: Devil's Dyke, Brighton, BN1 8YJ.

Directions and Car Parking: Traveling east or west on the A27 leave at the junction Grid TQ 285082 signposted for Hove on the A 2038. Turn north onto the Devil's Dyke Road to Grid TQ 258111. Devil's Dyke is a National Trust area and parking fee is £3 or free if you are a National Trust member with a membership card and display an up-to-date sticker in your car.

Public Transport: The nearest drop off point is Hove as the bus service from Brighton to Devil's Dyke stops at the end of September.

Dogs: Allowed if kept under control at all times.

Facilities: Toilets available outside the pub to the east of the main building. Food, drink and warmth at the Devil's Dyke pub (not National Trust).

E-Punching: Contactless punching will operate for those that have an appropriate card. Dibber hire SIAC £2 non-SIAC £1.

EOD Registration and Dibber Collection: Registration will be open from 09.30am until 11.30am. There will be maps for all courses available for entry on the day, but they will be limited; first come first served.

Start: From 10.00am (9:30 for helpers) – no allocated start times so just turn up and run The start is close to the registration. Competitors will enter the start box at -3 where loose pictorial description will be available. Yellow course maps and written control descriptions will be issued to competitors as they enter the -3 start box.

Finish: One finish for all courses approximately 75m from download. Follow tapes from the finish control to the download. Courses close 2.00pm.

The National Trust has granted access to Devil's Dyke and normally there are many other users on the area, please be polite to these.

Safety: Competitors are responsible for their own personal safety and for assessing their own ability to complete their chosen course. Parents / adults in charge of children should ensure that they are suitably clothed and prepared for the conditions.

Be aware of cattle around some part of the courses and of pedestrians and manoeuvring vehicles.

Devil's Dyke can get very exposed so whistles are strongly recommended and may be made mandatory in the event of poor weather. Similarly hooded waterproof jackets may also be made mandatory. Competitors are permitted to carry a mobile phone for use in an emergency and children and vulnerable adults are particularly encouraged to do so.

Full leg and torso cover is compulsory.

First Aiders will be on duty at the registration tent.
